

## FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – Lamont County Reeve Diduck Stands with Alberta's Ukraine Support

**February 28, 2022 – LAMONT, AB**: STATEMENT – As noticed in public media<sup>1</sup>, we have seen the Ivano-Frankivsk area and our twin community of Nebyliv, are experiencing bombing/missile attacks. We are very concerned for our twinning partners, and all Ukrainian people in the conflict region and across the world; we are supportive of the humanitarian efforts led by former Premier Stelmach and Premier Kenney's announcement of \$1M support for humanitarian aid from the Province.

Lamont County is the *Cradle of Ukrainian Settlement in Canada*. As such, Reeve **David Diduck**, supports Ukraine in its fight to retain independence and sovereignty. As a County leader, the Reeve expresses concern for all Ukrainians and our twinning partner Nebyliv, during this difficult time. "We wish for a swift and peaceful resolution to this war."
