



FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – Enbridge and Alliance Pipeline Provide Generous Donation to Lamont County Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) Summer Camp Programs

March 30, 2022 – LAMONT, AB: Lamont County has received support for its summer camp programs through generous donations from Enbridge and its partner Alliance Pipeline.
